Dear Parents/Carers,

Within our 'We are Geographers' topic in Year 3, the children are learning to use a variety of mapping skills and will create their own sketch maps. As part of our Geography fieldwork, we have chosen to visit Plymouth Hoe. This will be a great opportunity for the children to observe a local area and revisit their learning about human and physical geography.

Our walk will take place on **Wednesday 11th October**. Both classes will leave school at around 9:10am and will return to school for the afternoon session, after lunch. We have arranged for a coach to collect us from the Hoe at 1pm, after we have eaten our packed lunches and completed the morning's walk and fieldwork activities. In order to cover the cost of the return coach, there is a cost of £2.03 per child, payable via School Money in the usual way.

Together, we will walk to the Barbican and along Plymouth Hoe, with planned, regular stops to complete elements of their maps and discuss the local geography. The children will also have opportunities to stop for a snack, a drink and to use the toilet.

Please ensure that your child brings their own drink, a snack and a packed lunch within a bag. If your child is entitled to a free school meal, we ask that you choose a lunch option from the list below.

Please ensure your child wears their school uniform but has sensible shoes for walking and brings a waterproof jacket.

Please could you complete and return the form below by **Friday 6th October** to inform us of your consent and to order lunches.
