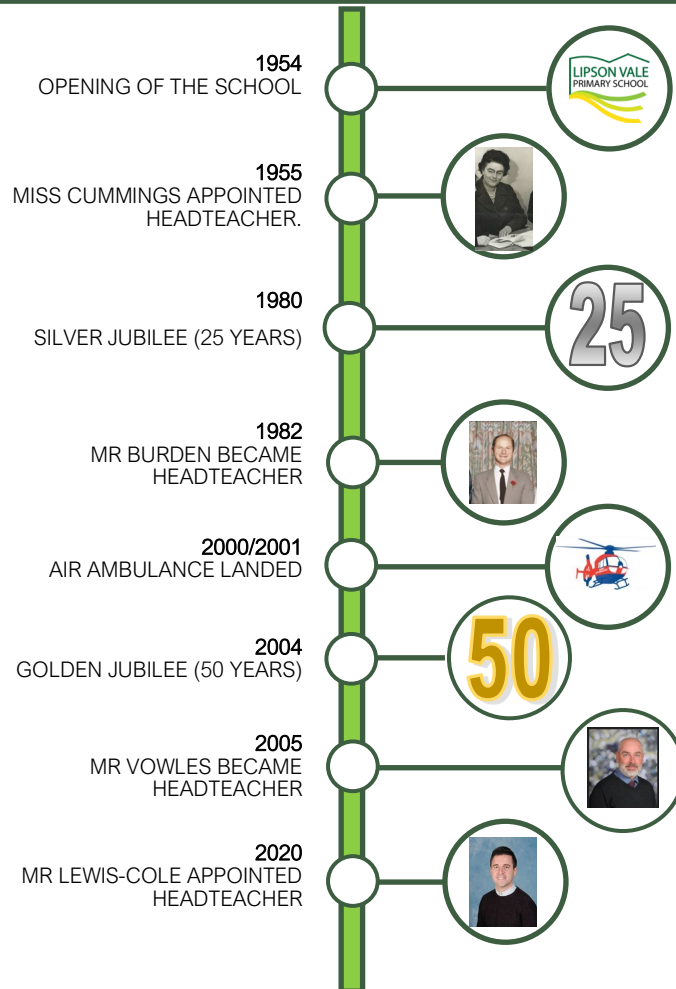

Past - Things that have already happened. Could be recent or a long time ago.



Chronological - Putting things into order based on their age.



History - Finding out about things in the past.



Timeline - A line with different years on, tells us more about how things have changed.



Resource - Could be pictures, stories, books or toys. They tell us more about the past.



Fact - Something that is true.



Present - Right now.



Future - What things could be like in the future.



Local Area - the area around the school.



Journey - travelling from one place to another (can be used to describe how people and places change over time.)



Voyage - a journey to a new place.



Pilgrims - People on a pilgrimage.



Mayflower - The ship that left the Barbican and travelled to the New World.
