RE: Your Child's School Health Needs

During the school year 2023/2024 all parents and carers of children in Year 1 in Plymouth are invited to complete a digital health and wellbeing questionnaire.

The purpose of this is to give you an opportunity to tell us about your child's health so that we can assess the health needs of your child and provide you and your child with any appropriate support, which may include online, telephone or face to face contact.

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The questionnaire contains helpful advice, a personalised care plan and signposting to appropriate online resources.

For the best experience when completing the questionnaire, we recommend using a modern web browser, such as the latest versions of Edge, Chrome, Safari or Firefox. This website is not supported by Internet Explorer and may not work correctly if this is used.

Some of following topics will be covered within the questionnaire.

- Emotional health and wellbeing
- Behaviour
- Physical Health & Development
- Dental health
- Continence (toilet training and /or bladder and bowel difficulties)

It will help to have the following information before you begin completing the questionnaire but not essential:

• Your child's NHS number

On submission, the information your child's health questionnaire will be added to the Livewell Southwest electronic record which will inform the School Nursing Service. These records might also be shared with other organisations on a need-to-know basis for the direct care of your child. This is to improve the quality and safety of the service provided. All providers must meet the highest standards of information security and are required by law to maintain confidentiality. Organisations that Livewell Southwest might share with include:

- Other NHS organisations
- GP

The extent to which information about your child may be shared as part of normal clinical practice may vary dependent upon the clinical service you are in touch with. This will be explained to you by your clinician. Your consent is implied by reading this notice and accessing this service. However, if you wish to refuse your child's information to be shared, either entirely or in part, please let us know, so we can respect your wishes and ensure this happens. There are some exceptional circumstances, such as where there are safeguarding concerns, where Livewell Southwest have a legal duty to share your information. If this is the case. Your clinician will discuss this with you.
