Dear Parent/Carer,

We have received the final information and details from the event organisers for the Schools Challenge on Sunday 28<sup>th</sup> April. Your child's t-shirt and race number will be available for collection on Tuesday 23<sup>rd</sup> April from 3:30-4pm in Orca class. This will allow you and your child to collect their t-shirt and race numbers, ensure medical information is up to date, and ask any questions about Race Day.

On Sunday, 28<sup>th</sup> April, we will be meeting at Smeaton's Tower Lighthouse at 11:00am. All children must arrive with their number attached to their t-shirt by 11:10am when we will then leave to walk up to the schools' compound on The Hoe. We must be in the compound by 11:15am as the gates will close promptly at this time, and no one else will be permitted to enter after this time, unfortunately. Please take note that the traffic will likely be busy due to several road closures for the half marathon, so plan your journey accordingly and allow plenty of time.

After the run, we will gather all the children back into their groups and walk back to Smeaton's Tower Lighthouse where we will then allow each child to leave. Please meet us there rather than trying to take your child as we leave the compound and walk across the Hoe. We will head straight back to Smeaton's Tower Lighthouse once all Lipson Vale children have completed the run. We are unable to specify an exact time as this may vary depending on the day's running times.

Additionally, the event organisers have mentioned that any child who competes on the day may have their photo featured on their website or future promotional materials. By taking part in the run, you are agreeing to this.
