**FOOTBALL ROADSHOW**  
Our Soccer Roadshows are age and football specific, with the aim of giving our young players fun, enjoyment and development. Sessions include skills, techniques, competitions and small sided games.

**GIRLS ONLY ROADSHOW**  
Girls of all abilities have the chance to learn new skills, receive new kit and really keep part of the football community. These sessions are aimed at creating 9-11 year pre-concussioners, about women's 11 girls football and sport participation while learning skills and techniques and enjoying small sided games.

**NISS PLEADING 11s - 10PM**  
Mini Hinged sessions are aimed at girls, 11-16 years, who are experiencing their first taste of a structured coaching session. Two sessions are held at a time of 10 coaches to 12 girls. The emphasis is on fun, learning and building confidence and concentration skills, whilst working on a range of football skills. The girls can develop in a safe and fun environment over the duration of the sessions.



**STINKERS & KIDDEPREENERS**  
This specific day can take a variety of different activities and games/learning. With opportunities for defenders and attackers to showcase their skills.

**SENIO ROADSHOW 10PM-11PM**  
Our Senior Roadshows, Health and Disability (RDH) Roadshows are inclusive sessions for children with a disability. This can be physical disabilities such as visual and hearing impairments, 20-25 seated pairs of children with learning needs such as autism and ADHD.

**MULTI SPORTS/SHILLS**  
Chance for our sports to undertake a wide range of sports throughout the day. Sports will be lawn football, handball, tag, netball, play many more. Every minute and area will offer different sports.

**SHORT BREAKS 10am-1pm**  
Fun and inclusive football and multi-sport activities for children aged 7-15 with a disability and educational health care plan (EHCP).
