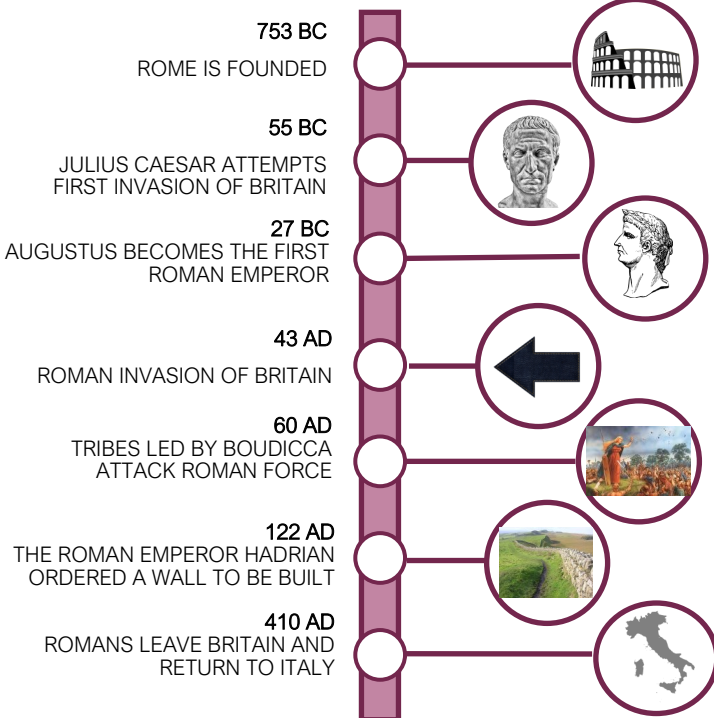


Romans: What was it like to live under Roman rule?

 Romulus and Remus: Mythical twin brothers and founders of Rome.	 Emperor Hadrian: The Roman Emperor known for building Hadrian's Wall.	

KEY PLACES



- Rome, Italy:** Where the Roman Empire started.
- Hadrian's Wall:** A wall built to protect Roman land.
- Londonium:** London.
- Pompeii:** A Roman town buried after a volcanic explosion in 79 AD.

KEY VOCABULARY

- Roman** - Something that comes from the Italian city of Rome.
- Empire** - 'A group of states or countries all ruled by one leader, called an emperor.
- Invasion** - One country attacking another to take it over.
- Conquered** - To overcome and take control of a place (or people) by military force.
- Legion** - One unit of the Roman army; had 4000 to 6000 soldiers in. Led by a centurion..
- Emperor** - The leader of an empire. Similar to a King or Queen.
- Amphitheatre** - Where the Romans would go to be entertained.
- Mosaic** - One picture made up of thousands of small tiles (tessellates).
- Senate** - The Roman Government.
- Celts** - People living in Britain and some parts of Europe during the Iron Age.
- BC (Before Christ)** - Used to show the years before Jesus was born.
- AD (Anno Domini)** - Used to show the years after Jesus was born.
