Details of the club are as follows:

Schedule:

Commencement Date:

The club will commence from the week beginning Monday, 22nd January until the week ending Friday 26th April.

Running Requirement:

Each participant is required to run 15 laps of the Multi-Use Games Area (MUGA) once a week during their allocated day. It is essential that your child joins the group going to the MUGA at lunchtime on the designated days to complete their laps.

Make-Up Runs:

If your child happens to miss a week, they will need to either run the mile at home or complete additional laps over the remaining weeks to catch up. This ensures a consistent level of participation and keeps everyone on track.

Payment Information:

To confirm your child's place in the Schools Challenge, please ensure you have paid the balance of ± 15 on School Money.

Record-Keeping:

We will maintain a central log of the laps your child completes during the club sessions. Additionally, there is a log sheet attached to this letter should your child wish to record any miles run at home or keep a personal log.
