Mountain A landform which is higher and steeper than a hill.

Frozen snow or water. **Iceberg** A large piece of ice which floats in the ocean.

**Temperature** A measurement of how hot or cold something is.

Compass An instrument which shows, North, South East or West.


**North Pole** The most northern part of the earth.
