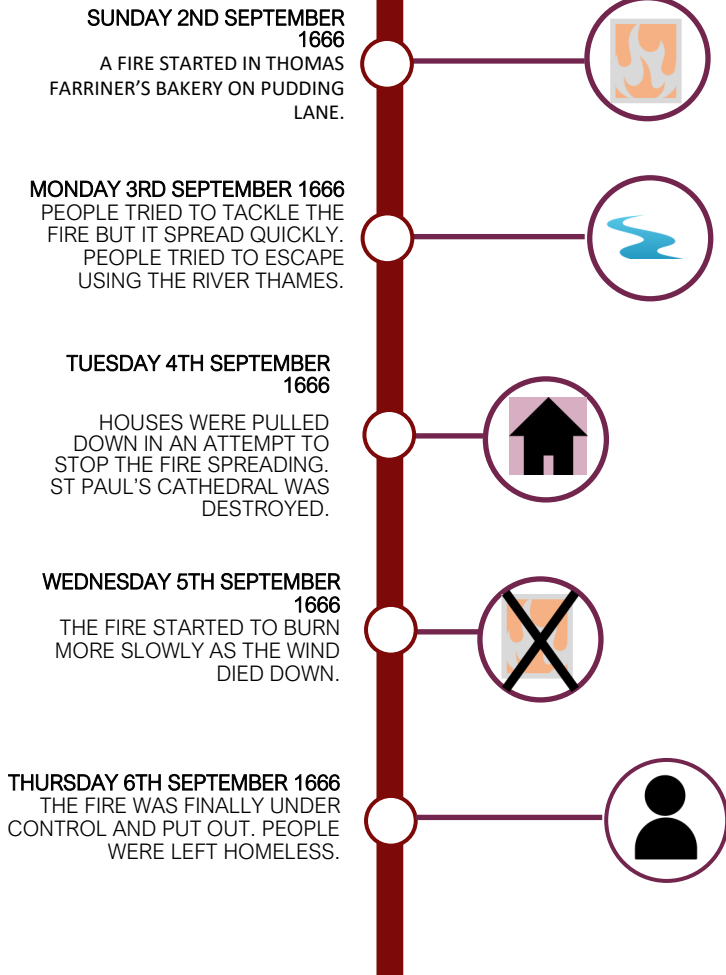
## HISTORICAL CONTEXT
