Dear Parents/Carers,

As part of our "We are Geographers" topic in Year 3, the children are developing their mapping skills and will be creating their own sketch maps. To support this learning, we are planning a Geography fieldwork trip to **Plymouth Hoe**. This will provide the children with a fantastic opportunity to observe a local area first-hand and to revisit their understanding of both human and physical geography.

Our walk will take place on **Thursday 9th October**. Both classes will leave school at approximately 9:15am and will return in time for the usual end-of-day collection.

During the day, we will walk through the Barbican and along Plymouth Hoe, making regular stops to complete elements of the children's sketch maps and to discuss the local geography. The children will also have opportunities for a snack, a drink, and toilet breaks. After lunch, we will continue our walk to explore further human geographical features, including the University and the Theatre Royal.

Please ensure your child brings:

- a named water bottle,
- a snack, and
- a packed lunch in a suitable bag.

If your child is entitled to a free school meal, please complete the lunch choice form attached.

Children should wear their school uniform along with **sensible walking shoes** and a **waterproof jacket** in case of rain.

We kindly ask you to complete and return the consent slip (and lunch order, if applicable) by **Monday 29th September**.
