Reading at home

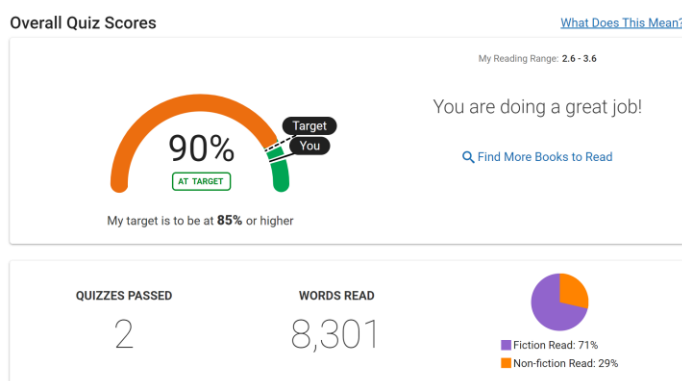
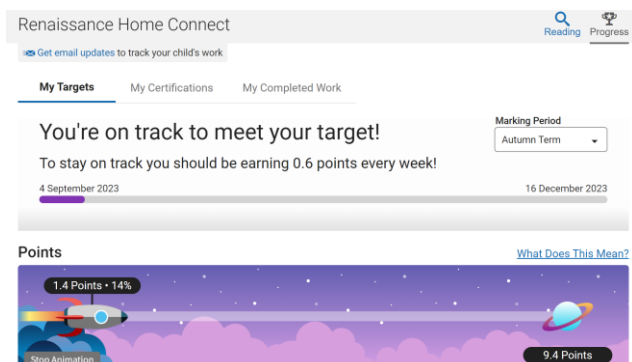
Reading Diary

Accessing Accelerated Reader at Home via Home Connect

Our Accelerated Reader website has been updated and we now have a new URL to access information about your child's reading progress. The feature, 'Home Connect', enables you to see your child's progress in Accelerated Reader, including the books your child has read and their average percentage correct on quizzes. Please note that your child has been set new reading targets at the start of this term.

You will also have the option to receive automatically generated emails about your child's progress in reading. Emails are sent when an Accelerated Reader quiz is taken.
