About the Challenge:

Race Day Requirements

Leading up to the race day on Sunday, 28th April 2024, all participants are required to complete a series of runs over set distances of ¼ mile, ½ mile, ¾ mile, or 1 mile, totalling 12 miles. These distances should be achieved and verified during designated lunchtime sessions at school or may be completed at home.
