Dear Parents/Carers,

The time has arrived for the much-anticipated SATs tests! We know how much commitment and effort that your children have put into their preparation for these over the last few months and really want to ensure that they have every chance to perform at their best during the week. Below you will find a timetable of the SATs tests that will be happening next week.

In order to help them with this we have drawn up a list of points which we hope you will be able to support us with:

- There will be a **SATs breakfast** which we encourage all children to come to. This is an opportunity for children to have an enjoyable start to the morning and get together with their friends. This will start at 8:15am and there will be a range of food for children to choose from. If your child does not attend the SATs breakfast, please make sure that they eat plenty to fuel their brains and ensure that they arrive at school promptly (8:45am)!
- The children will be in two groups with a small group of children sitting the SATs test later in the day. These children will be in Foundation until their test to avoid them coming into contact with children who have already completed the test. This is to ensure that all children have the additional support needed to access the test.
- We are encouraging children to have regular drinks to keep their brains active so a **water bottle**, which they can refill in school, would be advantageous.
- Children need plenty of **rest** in order to really show what they can do, so a good bedtime routine over the weekend and throughout next week would be beneficial.
- If children are unwell overnight, please let us know as soon as you can, before the start of school, so that we can make alternative plans if necessary.
- Please avoid booking any appointments for them during school hours this week.
- Please let us know if there are any extenuating circumstances which occur before or during this time which might have a detrimental effect on the general well-being of your child and thus their ability to manage the tests.
- We would like children to come in **school uniform on all days**. On Tuesday and Thursday, they will need to bring in their PE kits to change for PE later in the day.

**Following this week, the children will still be taking part in key learning so continued daily attendance is important.**
