Isle Of Wight Residential Week (8th - 12th July 2024)

Dear Parents and Carers,

As you may already know, for many years we have run a very successful residential week in the Summer term. This year there is an opportunity for children in Year 6 to participate once more in either a residential trip to The Isle of Wight or to stay in school for an Activities Week.

Details of the visit to The Isle of Wight

We will be taking a group of up to 40 children to stay in a hostel from Monday to Friday and the itinerary includes:

- A visit to Osborne House (summer residence of Queen Victoria)
- A visit to Black Gang Chine Adventure Park
- A drama workshop and theatre visit
- A visit to Tapnell Farm
- A visit to Alum Bay sand modelling and sweet making factory

The parental contribution is set at \pounds 337.26 and the deposit is \pounds 50.00.

This is a very popular trip and a great way to end Year 6, therefore the places will be allocated on a first come, first served basis. Parents should note that the deposit, once paid, is an indication of firm commitment to the visit and that the total payable by the school to the providers (for accommodation, travel, food, etc) has been negotiated on the basis of all children attending. It follows, therefore, that unless there are extreme circumstances, it will not be possible to refund deposits once this commitment has been made.

Once a place for your child has been confirmed, a payment plan can be put in place to spread the payments across the year, with the first instalment of \pounds 37.26 followed by five equal payments of \pounds 50. We have further split down the monthly payments, so you have the option to pay the amount in smaller chunks.
