

Compulsory Home Learning

Please continue to read and discuss books at home with your child on a regular basis. Record this reading on BoomReader. Continue to practise reading and spelling the year 2 common exception words (on the back of this sheet). Access Numbots at home to reinforce maths learning taking place in school.

Write a book review for Grandad's Island. – What do you like and dislike? – Would you recommend the story to a friend?	Paint a beautiful island scene. Can you apply your painting skills from our previous art learning?	Write a diary for a day on the island. What fun adventures could you have?
Create a world map – label the continents and oceans. Locate 5 interesting places Grandad could visit.	Design a tasty fruit skewer for Grandad and Syd to eat on the island.	Imagine that you could travel on Grandad's ship. Use a map to plan the journey that you would take around the world. Use your compass directions.
Design a new shelter for Grandad and Syd to use on the island.	Write your own island adventure story.	Create a model of Grandad's ship or the island using recyclable materials.
